



## Distance Accuplacer Testing

If you live outside of the state or are outside a 60-mile radius of MSC Southeast, you may take the Accuplacer test at a local community college or university following these steps:

1. Contact the school where you would like to take the Accuplacer to confirm they test for other schools and ask if there is a fee, which is the student's responsibility.
2. Contact MSC Southeast Testing Coordinator Kristie Maynard at [kmaynard@southeastmn.edu](mailto:kmaynard@southeastmn.edu) for a Remote Voucher. Please provide the following information:
  - Name of college where you would like to test
  - First and last name
  - Date of birth
  - Email Address
  - Phone Number
  - Address

If you live outside of the country, you can take your Accuplacer using an online, remote proctor, Examity. Contact MSC Southeast Testing Coordinator, Kristie Maynard at [kmaynard@southeastmn.edu](mailto:kmaynard@southeastmn.edu) or 507-453-1438 to set up an Examity Account. A \$25 proctor fee applies, which will be your responsibility.
