What is the C2C program?

- Provides academically challenging college courses to qualified students without leaving their high schools
- Decreases the expense of a college education by offering college-level credit courses while still in high school
- Courses are taught by high school instructors with the collaboration of college faculty
- C2C courses follow the high school calendar

What you and your parents need to know:

- C2C courses offer the same curriculum as courses held at Southeast in Winona, Red Wing, and online
- C2C courses are taught by qualified high school teachers who work in conjunction with a collaborating college faculty
- C2C courses have college-level rigor, depth and expectations

- Courses are typically part of the MN Transfer Curriculum
- May also transfer to other colleges and universities, including Minnesota private colleges
 - Courses may lead directly to employment (Engineering/CNC Certificate)

What are course expectations?

- Follow Southeast course outlines, objectives, outcomes, and assessments
- Maintain Southeast course rigor and depth for all assignments and testing
- As a general rule, for *each hour in class, allow two hours of time to study outside of class.*

 - Drop/Add dates (PSEO Law, <https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/cite/124D.09>)
 - If you register for a class and decide you no longer want to receive college credit, contact your high school teacher, counselor, or principal. You will need to log in to your e-Services account to complete the withdraw process. Contact the Director of Secondary Relations if assistance is needed in the process. If a student drops a class within the first 10 days, the course will not appear on the Southeast transcript.
 - After 10 days and up to 80% of the course, a dropped course appears as a “W” or ‘Withdrawal from Course’ grade on your college transcript and may affect your academic standing and future admission to other colleges.
 - Students may remain in the course and receive high school credit without college credit.

 - Cumulative GPA of 2.0 and 67% course competition
 - Academic Warning/Suspension
 - Impact on future Financial Aid

Grading Information

Grades

- No “+” or “-” are given in Concurrent classes
- “W” or “F” grades means earning no credit and could result in not graduating high school
- College transcripts will follow you for your entire college career
- Transfer course grades follows you to future colleges/universities

Attendance

- In class attendance is important and could affect your grade
